A prorated professional development (PD) credit system is utilized for new CCIFPs. All new CCIFPs will be placed in a prorated three-year recertification cycle for the initial certification period only.

For example, candidates passing the exam between April 1, 2016 and March 31, 2017 will be placed on a March 31, 2019 recertification date. The PD credit requirements and the recertification maintenance fee are prorated based on the following schedule, "Monthly Proration of First Year's PD Credit Requirement & Recertification Maintenance Fees."

All recertification maintenance fees are due on an annual basis by March 31st for the following year beginning April 1st. All PD credits must be reported by March 31st in the third year of the certification cycle. CCIFPs may refer to the "Professional Development Credit Policy for Recertification" for specific details on PD credit, eligible credit types, reporting requirements, carry-over allowances, and other important details.
